The parkour surface is currently too slippy and this activity will allow the surface to become more useful for the parkour runners. Danny is not charging for his time and all images will be sent to GLPC and MKC for approval. In the past this community art has helped to reduce the amount of ad hoc graffiti work and encourage ownership from youngsters – an event will be run to get feedback from the users. This expenditure would be covered from the Community Events budget. *Cllr Foskett*
  - 6.2. To agree to the tree works required at Pear Tree Pond following damage to the tree caused after the last high winds. This is maintenance work to ensure the future health of the tree. Cost is £520 and is catered for in the earmarked reserves as part of the long term maintenance. *Cllr Widdowson*
